On Monday your camper will be tie-dying their T Shirts (provided) and making name tags that will be left at camp each day except Friday when they can take them home. Please remember to have them dressed for crafting, playing and hiking in the woods. Hiking boots, old sneakers, or any other closed-toe shoes will work best. There is no reason to send any electronic devices. It is no fun trying to catch frogs in the pond while worrying about dropping your phone into the mud. We do recommend applying bug repellent and sun screen before arriving, although we do have an ample supply here at camp that would be applied by one of our staff if needed. Please let us know on the health form if you do not want us to provide that for you.

On the first day, because every camper is required to have a health screening done by one of our medical staff, camp check in begins at 8:30a-9a and check out will be starting at 3:00p. The rest of the week, 8:45a- 9 for check - in works great. Please make sure that the person to whom your camper will be released at the end of the day is listed on the camper information form and signs them out. Campers will be with their groups at the parking lot/ check in and out area. In the morning drop off, you do not need to sign them in.

Snacks and lunch will be provided daily. Our menu is available upon request. If your camper has any food allergies or special dietary needs, please make sure you note this on the registration form. To ensure your child's safety and to ease your mind, you may send a lunch/snack with them. This also needs to be noted on the registration form.

Water will always be available throughout the day in many areas of camp.

The Friday family program is from 2p-3p. Bring a chair and enjoy learning about the Adventures your camper has been on this week.

Our Camp Store will have items to purchase during the family program on Friday, including extra shirts, hand made headbands, drinks, pop, candy, and extra crafts the kids made during the week.
